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# Introduction

Before building starts, municipalities and construction companies want to be assured of positive support from the community on their project. That makes sense nowadays. As a citizen you have a (loud) voice and it is taken seriously.

I often make the comparison with a hotel... to earn 5 stars, you have to do more than just offer good rooms and food. People also want good service and sometimes a gift. For construction sites it means transparent communication and investing in social value. By listening to your guests and responding well, you will receive a higher rating, which means more support. It's all about building a good reputation.

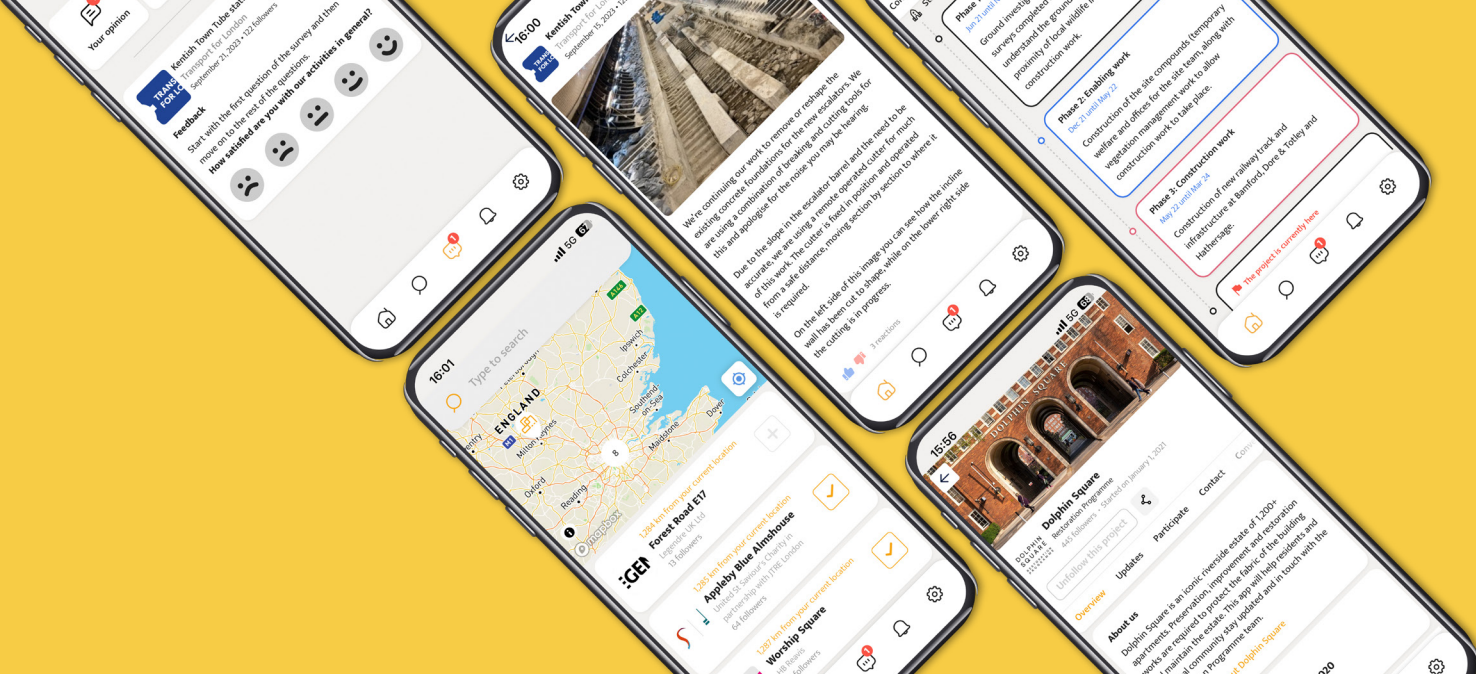

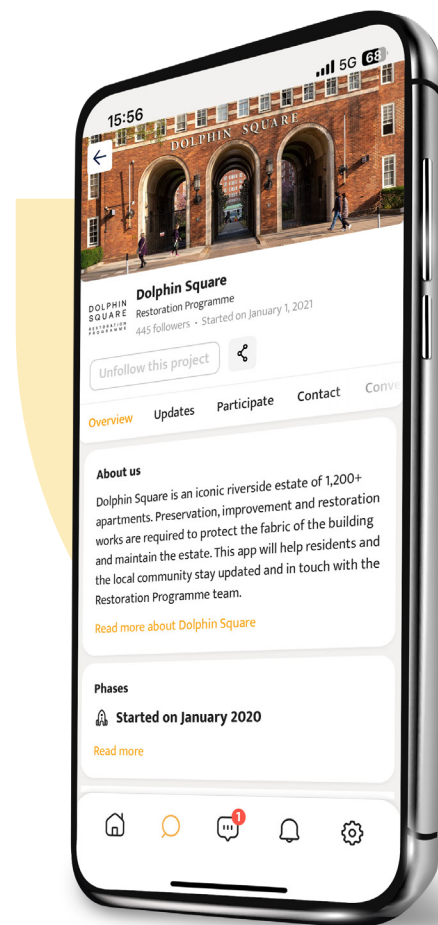
